## ORDER

New Delhi, the 17th December, 1979

**G.S.R. 696(E)/Ess. Com./Sugar.**- In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955 (10 of 1955), the Central Government hereby makes the following Order, namely :-

**1. Short Title, Extent and Commencement.**- (1) This Order may be called the Levy Sugar Supply (Control) Order, 1979.

(2) It extends to the whole of India.

(3) It shall come into force at once.

**2. Power to issue directions to supply Levy Sugar.**- (1) The Central Government may, from time to time, by order, issue directions to any \*<sup>2</sup>[producer or importer] or recognised dealer to supply levy sugar of such type \*<sup>1</sup>[or grade, in such quantities and from such place of manufacture or storage] :-

(a) to such persons or organisations, in such areas or markets; or

\*<sup>2</sup>[(b) to such State Government/Union Territory Administration, as may be specified in the order.]

**Explanation.**- "Levy" sugar means the sugar requisitioned by the Central Government under clause (f) of sub-section (2) of section 3 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955.

<sup>2</sup>[(I-A) The domestic producer shall supply levy sugar at a price not exceeding the price determined under sub-sec. (3-C) of Sec. 3 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955 and the importer of sugar shall supply at a price not exceeding the controlled price fixed under clause (b) of sub-sec. (3) of Sec. 3 of that Act.]

(2) The Central Government may by notified Order direct that the power to issue any direction under sub-clause (1), shall be exercisable also by any or

more of the following officers in the Directorate of Sugar, \*<sup>2</sup>[ Ministry of Consumer Affairs & Public Distribution, Department of Sugar and Edible Oils] New Delhi :-

1. The Chief Director (Sugar).
2. The Additional Chief Director.
3. A Director.
4. A Deputy Director.

(3) Where any direction is issued to any \*<sup>2</sup>[producer or importer] or recognised dealer under sub-clause (1) or (2) for the supply of levy sugar to any State Government that State Government may either arrange to take delivery of the sugar by itself or nominate any person, organisation or authority to take delivery of the sugar.

(4) Any levy sugar taken delivery of under sub clause (3) may be stored, distributed or sold-

(a) where such sugar has been taken delivery of by the State Government, in such manner as the State Government deems fit;

(b) in any other case, in accordance with such directions as may be issued by the State Government or by an officer or authority empowered by the State Government in this behalf.

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#### NOTIFICATIONS ISSUED UNDER THE ORDER:-

(1) **New Delhi, the 17th December, 1979.**

**G.S.R. 697 (E)/Ess. Com./Sugar.-** In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-clause (2) of clause 2 of the Levy Sugar Supply (Control) Order, 1979, the Central Government hereby directs that the power to issue any direction under sub-clause (1) of the said clause 2 shall be exercisable also by the Chief Director, Additional Chief Director, a Director or a Deputy Director in the Directorate of Sugar, Ministry of Agriculture and Irrigation, Department of Food.

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(2) **New Delhi, February 17, 2000**

**G.S.R. 136 (E)/Ess.Com./Sugar.-** In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-sec.(1) read with clause (c) of sub-sec.(2) of Sec.3 of the **Essential Commodities Act, 1955** (10 of 1955), the Central Government hereby directs that the controlled price of sugar, for the purpose of buying sugar from any

person other than a domestic producer of sugar, by the Central Government or as directed by the Central Government under the Levy Sugar Supply (Control) Order, 1979 as amended from time to time, shall be Rs. 1050.99 (Rupees one thousand fifty and paise ninty nine only) per quintal for the sugar season 1999-2000.

*Explanation.* -The price of Rs. 1050.99 (Rupees one thousand fifty and paise ninty nine only) per quintal is the weighted average of levy sugar price payable to domestic producers of sugar for the sugar season 1999-2000.

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(3) **New Delhi, January 30, 2001**

**G.S.R. 42 (E).**- In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-sec. (1) read with clause (f) of sub-sec. (2) of Sec. 3 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955 (10 of 1955), and in supersession of the Order of the Government of India in the erstwhile Ministry of Consumer Affairs and Public Distribution (Department of Sugar & Edible Oils) number GSR 137 (E) Ess. Com/ Sugar, dated the 17th February, 2000, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Central Government hereby directs that every domestic producer and importer of sugar shall sell fifteen per cent of the sugar produced or imported as the case may be, with effect from the 1st day of February, 2001 to the Central Government or as directed by the Central Government under the Levy Sugar Supply (Control) Order, 1979, as amended from time to time.

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(4) **New Delhi, March 1, 2002**

**G.S.R. 157 (E).**- In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) read with clause (f) of sub section (2) of Section 3 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955 (10 of 1955), and in suppression of the Order of the Government of India in the Ministry of Consumer Affairs. Food and Public Distribution (Department of Food and Public Distribution) number G.S.R. 42 (E), dated the 30th January, 2001, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Central Government hereby directs that every domestic producer and importer of sugar shall sell ten per cent of the sugar produced or imported, as the case may be, with effect from the 1st day of March, 2002, to the Central Government or as directed by the Central Government under the Levy Sugar Supply (Control) Order, 1979, as amended from time to time.

**G.S.R. 80(E):-** In exercise of the powers conferred by Sec. 3 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955 (10 of 1955) read with clauses 5 & 10 of the Sugar (Control) Order, 1966 and clause 2 of the Levy Sugar Supply (Control) Order, 1979, the Central Government hereby directs that every producer of sugar shall:-

(i) Sell and despatch the monthly quota of sugar released to him for sale by the monthly release order within the period specified therein; and

(ii) Report the particulars of the sales and despatches of sugar made by him during each week within seven days from the date of expiry of that week in the form of return annexed to this Order to the Chief Director (Sugar), Directorate of Sugar, Department of Food and Public Distribution, New Delhi.

(iii) This order shall come into force on the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.
